## TRAINING INFORMATION SHEET

### TUBE AND FITTING SCAFFOLD INSPECTION

<b>Course overview</b>	A tested and company certificated activity-based course with a syllabus covering the legal aspects and theory related to scaffold structures in accordance with TG20 and The Work at Height Regulations. The course takes a holistic approach to scaffold inspection although has heavy technical content and a simulated scaffold inspection activity to evaluate the understanding gained by delegates.
<b>Course duration</b>	8 hours
<b>Suitability</b>	This course is intended for persons wishing to gain knowledge of the requirements of TG20 and those responsible for scaffold inspection in relation to structures covered by that guidance. It is expected that those attending will have some previous experience of scaffold structures.
<b>Venue</b>	Ashford, Kent Training Centre (address above) or client's premises.
<b>Delegate numbers</b>	Expected 10-12 but no more than 16. Minimum of 5 for the course to run.
<b>CPD</b>	As allowed by the delegates association.
<b>Assessment</b>	Initial and formative through tutor evaluation of activities and summative written test and simulated inspection with written report.
<b>Certification</b>	H & K Training Services Limited's own certification stating; 'successful completion' or 'attended' dependent upon assessment results. Validity duration is recommended as three to five years depending upon the delegates continuing use of the information and changes that may be made to legislation or TG20.
<b>Materials</b>	All required course materials and equipment will be provided.
<b>Catering</b>	Hot and cold beverages and a buffet lunch will be provided.
<b>Dress code</b>	Casual but no soiled footwear or clothing at our Training Centre please.
<b>Course fees</b>	To be determined through contact with the Training Centre.
<b>Booking</b>	Through Hayley Ford at the above contact details and via our booking form. Joining instructions will be provided in advance of the course commencement.
